Fees are due on the Friday before each school term starts and late payment will result in a late payment charge of 2% per month. Fees may be paid by direct debit, bank transfer or credit/debit card (but not American Express).

## **Nursery fees**

Parents may opt for 38 weeks or 50 weeks pa and session costs vary depending on EYEE funding entitlement. Additional hours beyond those shown below cost £6 per hour. Breakfast, lunch, high tea and snacks are included in the costs shown below. Pupils are required to complete 4 sessions per week in order that they can settle more easily into the Nursery (full day counts as 2 sessions).

Sessions are booked for one term in advance, with half a term's notice required for a reduction of sessions. If you wish to increase your sessions you may do so depending on availability, but any additional costs must be paid on receipt of your amended invoice. Fees may be paid by direct debit, bank transfer or credit/debit card (but not American Express). We also accept childcare vouchers and tax-free childcare payments. Fees are payable in advance, either in full on the first day of the billed term, or in instalments as shown below.

Non-payment of fees may lead to your child being excluded from sessions until payment is made in full.

## **Additional notes**

1. The Deposit will be refunded with the final invoice after the child has left minus the last term's disbursements. Deposits must be paid and the application form must be signed, thus agreeing to the Terms and Conditions, before the child starts at the School.
2. Overseas parents mean those domiciled outside the UK and EU but not including UK Government or military parents on overseas duty.
3. The following are in addition to the basic fee in the Senior School: Sixth form textbooks and some texts and work books where notes have to be made in the book, some materials used for items made in practical subjects and some trips.
4. The School reserves the right to disclose any unpaid financial obligation on transfer of a pupil to another school.
